Dr. Chiu is a professor of Pediatric Infectious Diseases and currently director of the Molecular Infectious Disease Research Center at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, Chang Gung University College of Medicine in Taoyuan, Taiwan. He received his medical degree from the Chung Shan Medical University and his doctorate from the Graduate Institute of Clinical Medicine, Chang Gung University College of Medicine. He completed a residency in pediatrics at the Department of Pediatrics, Chang Gung Memorial Hospital, and a postdoctoral fellowship at the Department of Pediatrics, University of British Columbia, Vancouver, British Columbia, Canada. Dr. Chiu's research interests focus primarily on pediatric infectious diseases, antimicrobial resistance mechanism, vaccines, *Salmonella* pathogenesis, and bacteria-host interaction. Currently, at Chang Gung Memorial Hospital he leads the infection control committee and also continues to pursue and expand his studies in microbial genomics, bacteria-host interaction, and microbiome. He is the recipient of several research awards, primarily in the area of infectious diseases. Dr. Chiu is a member of the Pediatric Infectious Diseases Society, Taiwan Pediatric Association, and Infectious Diseases Society of Taiwan, among other associations. In addition, Dr. Chiu has been reviewing manuscripts for a number of medical journals, including *Journal of Infectious Diseases*, *Clinical Infectious Diseases*, *Pediatric Infectious Disease Journal*, and *Clinical Microbiology and Infection*, and currently serves as the chief editor of the *Pediatrics and Neonatology* and editor of *Paediatrics and International Child Health*, *Journal of Microbiology, Immunology and Infection*, *Biomedical Journal*, *Journal of Medical Microbiology*, and *Journal of Formosan Medical Association*. He is in the internal advisory board to the *Journal of Pediatric Infectious Disease Society* and *Clinical Infectious Diseases*. He has authored or co-authored more than 400 scientific papers, including some in highly prestigious journals such as *New England Journal of*

Medicine and *Lancet*, for which he has earned international recognition. Moreover, he is the author of 5 book chapters and has presented papers at many national and international scientific and medical meetings.
